

# RE-DWELL ITN Kick-off sessions

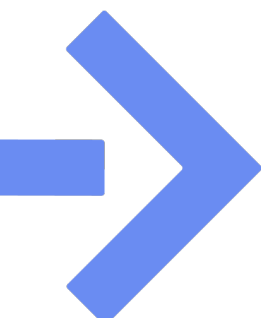
Introduction to RE-DWELL and to the kick-off programme.

<p><b>THIRD SESSION</b> <b>Tuesday, July 6</b> <b>(14:00 to 16:00 CET)</b></p>	<p><b>INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH</b></p> <p>To seek links between individual projects, and their relationships to the research areas.</p>	<p><b>ESR projects</b> (14:00 to 15:30)</p> <p>Each ESR gives a 5-minute presentation of their project while peers summarize the presentations in a shared mind map, and establish links between the ESRs' projects.
