RE-DWELL ITN Kick-off sessions

July 2, 5, 6 and 8, 2021

The aim of this four-session programme is to kick-start the network activities by enabling RE-DWELLers to get to know each other and begin working together on the research and training activities. Early-stage researchers, supervisors, co-supervisors, and secondment representatives are invited to participate in this programme. The work done in these sessions will represent the first step in the construction of the RE-DWELL innovative network; a process which will continue with the following training and research activities.

Programme

FIRST SESSION

Friday, July 2 (14:00 to 16:00 CET)

RESEARCH TEAM

To introduce the members of the network: ESRs, supervisors, cosupervisors and secondment representatives

Welcome (14:00 to 14: 15)

Introduction to RE-DWELL and to the kick-off programme.

Team presentation (14:15 to 16:00)

Supervisors, co-supervisors and secondment representatives introduce themselves in 1 minute, with 3 pictures and 3 key words.

ESRs introduce themselves with a 2-minute video.

During the session, participants will collaboratively create a mind map to find affinities between team members.

SECOND SESSION

Monday, July 5 (14:00 to 17:00 CET)

PROJECT RESEARCH

To explore the multiple meanings of the three key research topics

Affordability (14:00 to 14:45)

Teams of 3 ESRs discuss the meanings of housing affordability.

Sustainability (14:45 to 15:30)

Teams of 3 ESRs discuss the meanings of housing sustainability.

Transdisciplinarity (15:30 to 16:45)

Teams of 3 ESRs discuss the meaning of transdisciplinarity for housing research.

In the last 15 minutes of each of the three sessions, a collaborative mind map will be created with the outcome of the discussions.

Discussion (16:30 to 17:00)

Wrap-up of the outcomes of the three sessions.

THIRD SESSION

Tuesday, July 6 (14:00 to 16:00 CET)

INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH

To seek links between individual projects, and their relationships to the research areas.

ESR projects (14:00 to 15:30)

Each ESR gives a 5-minute presentation of their project while peers summarize the presentations in a shared mind map, and establish links between the ESRs' projects. There will be a mind map created by each of these teams:

- Team 1: ERS 1, ERS 2, ERS 3
- Team 2: ERS 4, ERS 14, ERS 19
- Team 3: ERS 10, ERS 5, ERS 13
- Team 4: ERS 6, ERS 11, ERS 15
- Team 5: ERS 7, ERS 8, ERS 12

Discussion (15:30 to 16:00)

The findings of each of the five teams will be summarized in a shared mind map; links between ESRs' projects will be identified and discussed.
